Empower students with imagination, curiosity, and positive values through the reading of these four stories in class:

“The Amazing Flight of Little Ray” – A story about setting goals, practicing, and persevering despite obstacles.

“Little Ray & Shark Patch Things Up” – Addresses misconceptions about sharks and explores how reputations can be repaired.

“Raccoons Save the Day” – A compassionate rescue adventure that encourages teamwork and problem-solving.

“The Foxy Armadillos” – A heartwarming story of adaptation showing that sometimes the best way to win is to roll with it.

Readers who complete the challenge earn a handmade coin, overlaid with a stingray on the front and a sand dollar on the back – a one-of-a-kind token of curiosity and effort. The 24 wooden coins are handcrafted in shades of driftwood, blue, coral, and sand – each one unique, just like each child.

Donations send these animal stories to a school media center and establish our Coins for Curiosity program for a class.
